"Memorial Day"

Monday marks our country's celebration of Memorial Day. Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day and observed early after the Civil War. After the 2 world wars, congress designated it Memorial Day to honor all those who have lost their lives in the service of our nation. It is right to honor the men and women who offered the ultimate sacrifice to gain and preserve the freedoms we enjoy as Americans.

As Christians, we celebrate a different kind of Memorial Day. It happens every Sunday as we remember the ultimate sacrifice that God made for our spiritual freedom. The Lord's Supper, or Communion, was established by Jesus Himself in the upper room, the night before His crucifixion. He took the unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine and said that these represented His body and blood that was to be sacrificed. He told them to continue this memorial in His remembrance. The early church met every first day of the week to keep this command.

When we assemble on Sundays, we do so for many reasons. We worship and praise our God. We pray together. We learn from God's word. We encourage each other. But most importantly, we share in the communion and remember the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Obviously, we should remember Jesus every day. But on Sundays, we do it as a church family. As a congregation. As a gathering of God's family.

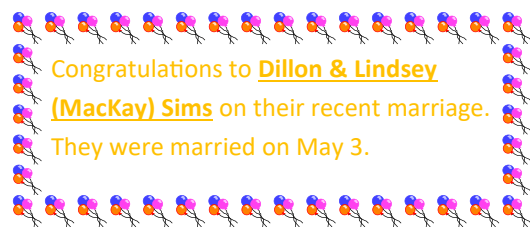
