"The Lord Turned and Looked Straight at Peter"

It had been a long night. It started in the upper room. The washing of the disciples feet. The bread, the fruit of the vine. The calling out of Judas. And then Jesus predicts what was about to happen: His arrest and death. Peter, always ready to speak, declares that he would die before he let something happen to Jesus. Jesus then tells him that before the rooster crows in the morning, he will deny Jesus three times.

Then they go to the garden. Jesus prays and Judas arrives with the temple guards. Peter pulls his sword and chops off an ear. Jesus heals the ear and is arrested. He is led to the house of the high priest. Peter follows at a distance and remains in the courtyard. While in the courtyard, he is confronted on three separate occasions and asked if he was with Jesus. Three times he denies even knowing Jesus. As soon as he made the third denial, the rooster crowed. Jesus, standing on the balcony "turned and looked straight at Peter". Peter went out and wept.

I have often wondered what kind of look it was Jesus gave Peter. We've all gotten "the look". Maybe from a parent, teacher or spouse. But was this a look of "I told you so"? A look of anger? A look of disappointment? A look of sadness? I don't know. But knowing Jesus I think, somewhere in all of that, was a look of encouragement. A look of, "It'll be alright".

The young people sometimes sing a song called, "Can He Still Feel the Nails?". We all stumble and fall. We all sin. We all at times disappoint God. And Jesus looks down on us. Reminding us, that even in our failures, there is still hope and encouragement. Jesus went on to use Peter for great things and He can still use you too.
