### NO CHANCE MEETING-TIME AND CIRCUMSTANCE

Philip meets the Ethiopian eunuch at his carriage, and from there the conversation begins and Philip teaches him about Jesus. Moments later, Philip baptizes him, and the eunuch goes off rejoicing in the Lord, not seeing Philip again. Paul enters the city of Philippi and on the Sabbath goes outside the city to the river to find a place of prayer. He meets women praying there and preaches the gospel and Lydia and her household were baptized into Christ. She now receives them in her home as a believer. On the road to Damascus, as Paul was going to arrest believers, Jesus appears to him, and he tells Paul to go into the city, and he will be told what he must do. He goes into the city and meets a man named Ananias. Ananias in turn tells him what God has transmitted to him and Paul was baptized into Christ.

What can we already notice in these moments in the book of Acts? There are no chance meetings. Philip met the Eunuch, Paul met Lydia, Jesus met Paul on the way to Damascus. Each in their own time and their own circumstance. What is going on? How do you explain these meetings? Paul explains this very well when he speaks at the Areopagus in Athens in Acts 17. He would declare in Acts 17:26-27 **"From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. 27 God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us."** We can see several things happening in these verses. The first work we see is that God is leading the lost to a place that He has determined so that they may seek out and find him. If an unbeliever asks "What is my purpose, why am I in this place I am in right now?" We can answer by saying so that they may find the Lord! Also, for us who are in Christ, we should be aware that the Lord puts people around us so that they may hear the gospel. It is good to be aware of this concept. Matthew 28:19 says "therefore, go...." I am sure you have heard that means "as you are going" which means as we go throughout this world God is joining the lost and saved together in order that the lost may be saved. Keep in mind what a great privilege and responsibility this is for us. We can be fully assured that in our walk the Lord brings people to us so that we may continually seek His will, and that He sets up a time and circumstance for the lost to meet us. Let us be ready to make the most of every opportunity. God is using you for such a time as this (Esther 4:14).
